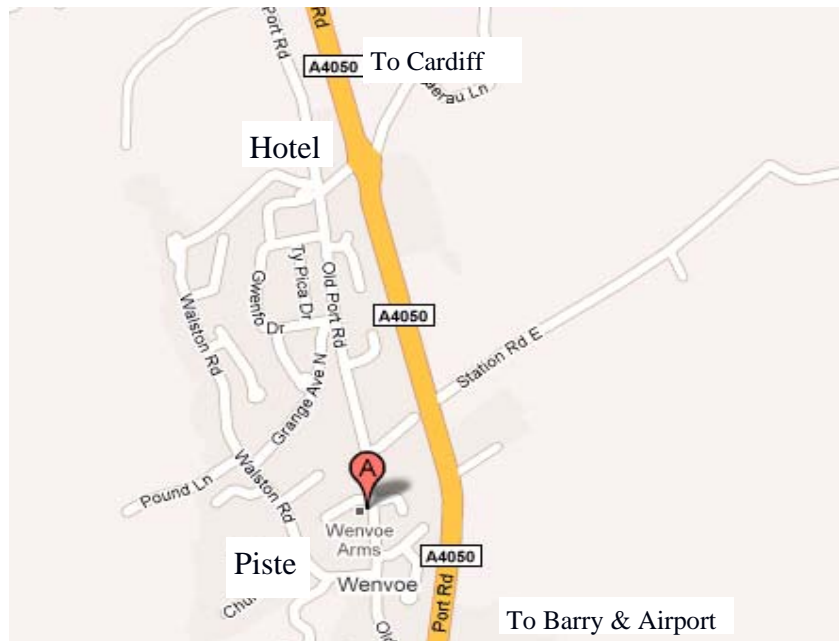


WENVOE PETANQUE CLUB

Wenvoe Petanque Club is the oldest petanque club in Wales and one of the oldest in Britain. The club was formed in the 1970s and grew quite rapidly from small beginnings.

The original club terrain at the Wenvoe Sports Ground is still in use, but a couple of years ago it was decided to build some pistes at the Wenvoe Arms public house in the village to take advantage of the better facilities that the pub could offer to players in competitions.

The pub is about 400 metres from the Walston Castle Hotel and can be reached by walking along Old Port Road through the village.
